Affiliated Locations: Lives in London, UK; travels frequently to Scotland, Wales to historic pagan sites; vacations in Paris; Formerly lived in the USA in Seattle WA, Boston MA and Albany NY; often seen at Delilah's Rare Books and the Bean Space 1-Room Café in Camden, London.

Habits and Routines: Takes daily walks from his home through Leathermarket Park; Stops at Bean Space for espresso; Haunts Deliah's Rare books, often for entire weekend, never buys books, possible affair. Fencer. Always buys curry from Joy of India. Goes off the grid for sabbatical, efforts to follow have failed.

Title: Professor of History (Tenured)

Description: Research focuses on the Christianization of the Pagan sites and rituals. Has published numerous articles on what he calls "Ritualistic Shift" Unpublished notes fixate on the efficacy of ritual when blocked or co-opted by outgroups.

Is noted to be a particularly difficult, unavailable professor. Will cancel classes without warning. Will appear in disarray in front of students. Will leave in the middle of lecture. Target of student pushes to "remove incapable faculty". Efforts have failed.

GOI Connections: Delilah's Rare Books is a known front for Serpent's Hand activities. Several anomalous objects including SCP-[REDACTED]; SCP-[REDACTED] and SCP-[REDACTED] have been traced back to the store. Delilah herself has been identified as the owner and operator of the Serpent's Hand darkenet forum, The Mating Ball but has not been associated directly with anomalous behavior. Intelligence officers have flagged both Delilah and Dr. Pennywise as SH vectors.
