Habits and Routines: Lives in a houseboat on Albert Dock; Takes walks in Speke Airfield; Explores abandoned sections of the Williamson Tunnels; Often visits the Hydraulic accumulator tower at the end of the Brambly-Moore dock; Maintains a studio on Lark Lane.

Title: Artist

Description: Work focuses on the intersection between the artificial and the natural. Famous for her series of mixed media pieces "In the Hidden Corners of Places" and for her photographs of "reclaimed buildings".

Is known to have participated in acts of civil disobedience regarding governmental surveillance and misconduct by national security agencies. Believes that "We have the right to speak freely and the right to silence and solitude."

GOI Connections: Delilah's Rare Books is a known front for Serpent's Hand activities. Several anomalous objects including SCP-[REDACTED]; SCP-[REDACTED] and SCP-[REDACTED] have been traced back to the store. Tang's relationship to the SH is not clearly established. She is friendly to several hand members but has not revealed that she is part of the fold.

It is worth noting that Tang is involved with political causes that further SH priorities, namely, reducing the surveillance profile of donor states. This is likely part of an effort to undermine containment through traditional channels.
